

x Establish legal ties:

- o Permanent employment of 30 + hours will be a factor (if taking more than 6 credits a quarter during the first year of being present in Washington State).
- o Driver's license/state ID. Students must obtain a Washington State Driver's License within 30 days of arrival if they have a current out-of-state driver's license. A Washington State Identification Card must be obtained if student has no driver's license.
- o All motor vehicles, RV, boat, mobile home registrations. All registrations must be registered in Washington. Students who own or drive a vehicle in Washington must be registered in Washington within 30 days of arrival .
- o Voter registration. Students who have a current out-of-state in Washington. If the student Washington, this means that s/he may still vote at residency

ce domicile is established, the student may be eligible for in-state tuition 12 months from the
e of arrival if all

___ legal ties were in place within 30 days. This is because the Washington statute says that domicile must be in existence for one year immediately prior to the first day of the quarter for which the student wants to be classified as a resident.

The determination for residency can be complicated and other factors may help students establish proof of domicile. After filling out the residency questionnaire a residency officer will review it and may request additional documentation. Please be prepared with copies of all the information supplied on the questionnaire.
